1. RULES

This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS) as changed by RRS Appendix E, this Notice of Race (NOR), the Sailing Instructions (SI's) & the Dragon Flite 95 Class Rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY, DF 95 POINTS & MEASUREMENT

All class legal DF 95's are welcomed to participate in this Regatta. All boats are expected to be class legal and the race committee reserves the right to confirm DF 95 class rule conformity on a random basis.

Sailors may compete in either or both regattas. Sailors competing in both regattas complete the Spring – Fall series with combined scores reported.

3. FEES

The entry fee for each regatta is \$20, LUNCH & LIMITED DRINKS PROVIDED TO SAILORS, feel free to bring your own lunch.

SPECIAL NOTES:

A limited number of charter free "race ready loaner" DF 95's are available.

DPMYC may utilize GPS controlled/positioned and remotely placed course buoys.

DPMYC may deploy RC rescue and buoy launch as needed.

Penalties available to the RD and/or Race Committee include a one-turn penalty without a hearing exclusion from the race in question, or expulsion from the regatta.
