1. RULES

This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS) as changed by RRS Appendix E, this Notice of Race (NOR), the Sailing Instructions (SI's) and the CR-914 Class Rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY & MEASUREMENT

All class legal CR-914's are welcomed to participate in this Regatta. All boats are expected to be class legal and the race committee reserves the right to confirm CR-914 class rule conformity on a random basis. Please refer to CR 914 CLASS RULES INTERPRETATIONS updated 08.24.2024 items 26 and 27. Complete CR 914 CLASS RULES INTERPRETATIONS included with 2024 CR 914 Nationals SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

3. FEES

The entry fee is \$35, LUNCH & LIMITED DRINKS PROVIDED TO SAILORS, feel free to bring your own lunch.

DPMYC may utilize GPS controlled/positioned and remotely placed course buoys. DPMYC may deploy RC rescue and buoy launch as needed.

9. CORINTHIAN SPIRIT

In the event of any behavior which is deemed to be a breach of good manners or sportsmanship, or which may bring the sport into disrepute, the Race Director or other designated Race Official will protest the party(ies) in accordance with RRS 2 and may ask any sailor to leave.

Penalties available to the RD and/or Race Committee include a one-turn penalty without a hearing exclusion from the race in question, or expulsion from the regatta.
